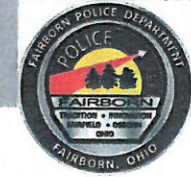

# FAIRBORN CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY



To provide Fairborn citizens with a better understanding of the Police Department, the officers, and their day-to-day responsibilities, the Fairborn Police Department is offering a FREE Citizens Police Academy.

The Citizens Police Academy is a twelve week course, that will meet every Thursday, dealing with all aspects of law enforcement roles, operations, and community service. Taught by Fairborn officers, participants can expect to learn about SRO, shoot/don't shoot scenarios, patrol, crash and OVI investigations, firearms safety, and much more.

## REGISTRATION

The Citizens Police Academy is open to Fairborn residents and business owners over 18 years old. To ensure all participants receive the maximum benefit from the program, class size is limited to sixteen (16) and will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis.
